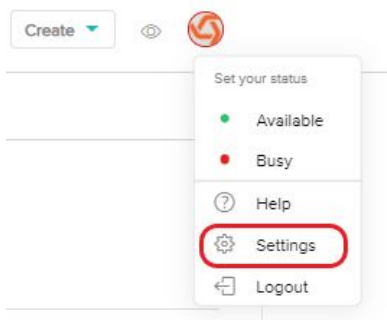


Boomtown Platform - Setting Up Slack Integration

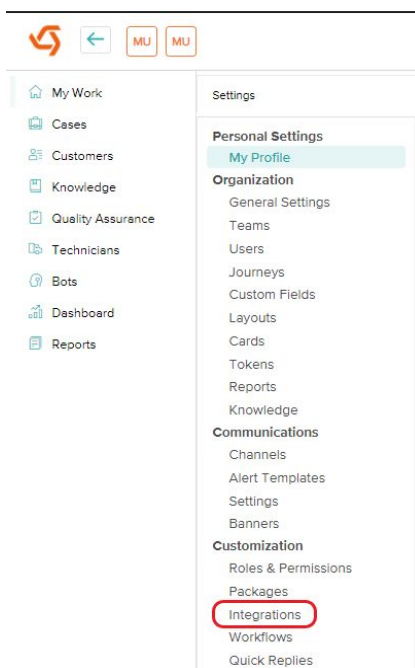
The Slack integration allows users in the Boomtown platform to chat with others via a Slack channel to maximize efficiency by eliminating the need to log-in to the platform for each communication.

Follow the instructions below to set up your Slack integration with the Boomtown Platform:

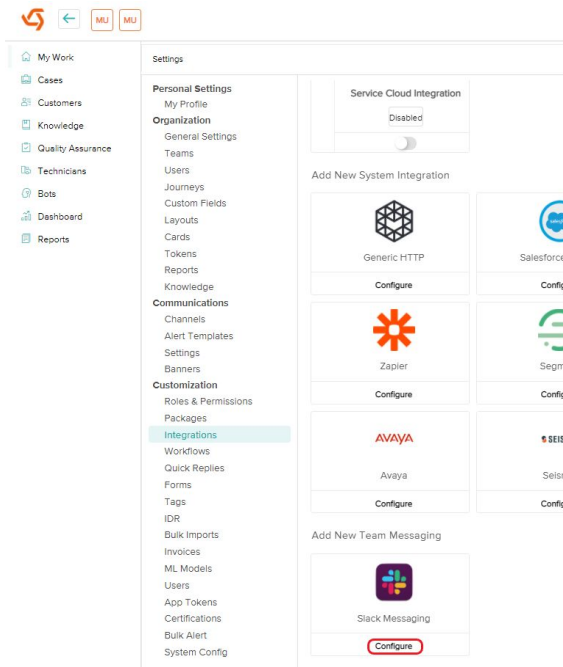
1. After logging into the [Boomtown Platform](#), click on your user icon in the upper right, then click on **Settings**:



2. From the settings menu, click on **Integrations**:



3. Scroll down until you see **Add New Team Messaging**. Click on **Configure** under **Slack Messaging**.



4. Fill out the following profile fields:

- **Type:** select Slack Messaging from the dropdown.
- **Name:** type the name you want to be displayed in the list of your Team's Integrations.
- **Description:** (optional) type the description of your Slack Integration.
- **Status:** select Enabled from the dropdown.

The 'Integration Setup' form contains the following fields:

- Team*: Boomtown Demo Org Level 1
- Name*: Slack Messaging
- Description: Sends chat messages into a Slack channel, an incoming-webhook in Slack terms.
- Status*: Enabled

5. Click **Save** to continue setting up the Integration. A new tab or window should pop up in your web browser.

6. Click **Allow**. The page that loads next will include the steps and important settings necessary to set up the integration on Slack. Click on the link provided in Step 1 to activate the outgoing Slack webhooks:

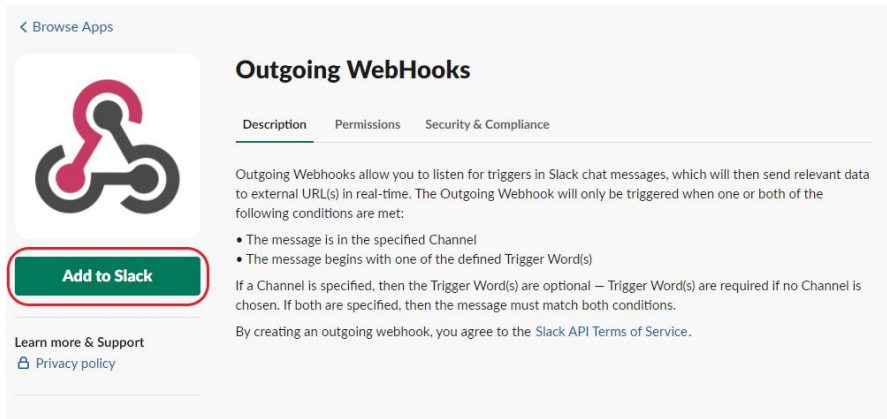

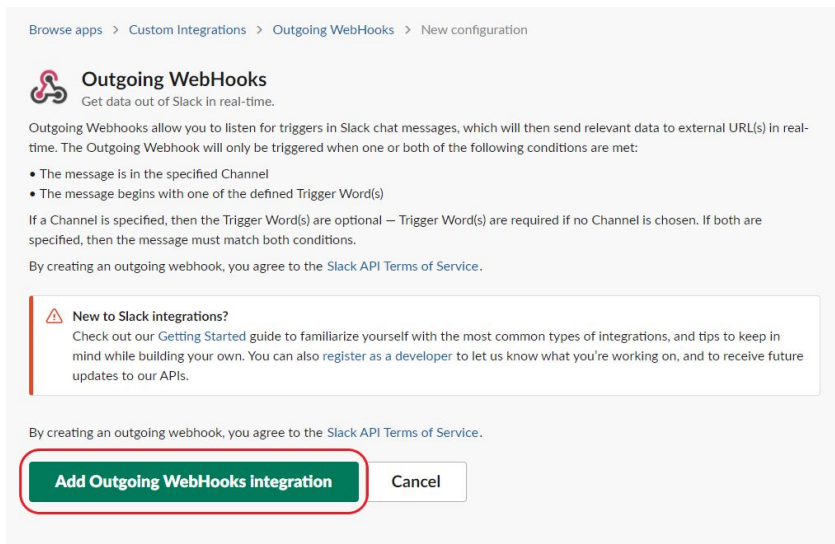

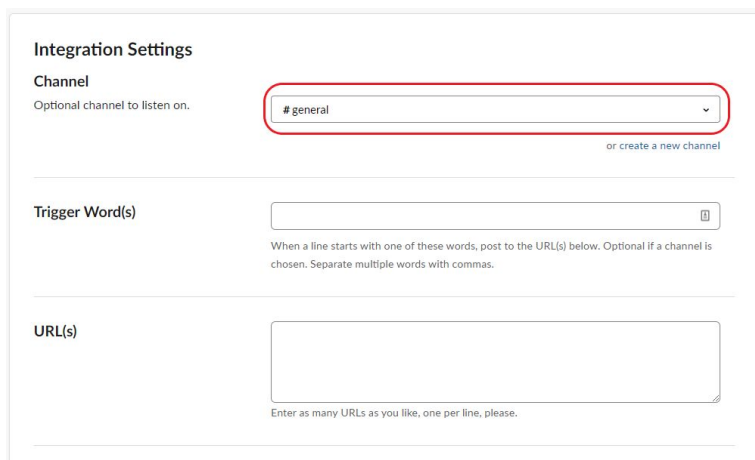
7. A new tab or window should pop up in your web browser. Click on **Add to Slack**:



8. Click on **Add Outgoing WebHooks Integration**:



9. Scroll down to **Integration Settings**. Select the Slack channel you would like messages from Boomtown to appear from the dropdown menu next to **Channel**. This should be the same channel you selected in step 5 of these instructions:



10. Make sure to leave the field next to **Trigger Word(s)** blank. This will make sure all messages are delivered to your Boomtown chat room.

11. Go back to the tab or window in your web browser with the integration instructions listed. Copy the entire URL listed under **Step 3: Integration Settings** and paste it next to URL(s) in the tab or window with the **Slack Integration Settings** open:

Scroll down to "Integration Settings" to configure Boomtown as the recipient.

In the "Channel" drop down menu, select the channel that was just setup to receive messages from Boomtown.


Leave "Trigger Word(s)" empty to send all chats to your Boomtown chatroom and paste this url into the "URL(s)" field.
